

## **GCSE Results Summer 2022**

Year 11 students at Gravesend Grammar School celebrated a superb year of results.

52% of all grades were awarded at a 7-9 level whilst 32% were awarded at 8-9 highlighting a high percentage of top end levels achieved at GGS. 63% of all grades in Mathematics were awarded at the top 7-9 band, and 59% of those in English. Computer Science (74% 7+), Geography (63% 7+) Maths (63% 7+) and Physics (63% 7+) were also notably high performing subjects.

98% achieved a good pass in English and Mathematics, while 95% gained a strong pass in both subjects. We are particularly pleased in the current educational climate that 89% of our students passed their English Bacculaureate which contains a challenging and rigorous set of subjects. To achieve the Ebacc, students need to attain strong grades in English, Maths, Science, a Humanity and a Language.

The 'Attainment 8' measure, average pupil achievement across 8 qualifications, including English and maths and at least 3 other rigorous English Bacculaureate qualifications is 67.83.

With regards to individual performance, 33 pupils have attained an average level of an 8-9. 21 pupils got 7 or more 8's/9's and 58 pupils got 7 or more 7's which are all improvements upon 2019.
